

SNOW EMERGENCY-CITY OF HASTINGS

****PRESS RELEASE****

Due to the amount of snow and the high winds, the City of Hastings **is extending the Snow Emergency until noon on 2/4/16**. This will allow the street department time to get the downtown and the snow emergency routes cleaned and ready for parking.

During the hours the snow emergency alert is in effect, no vehicles may be parked on the City's snow emergency routes. Almost all the City's stop sign protected streets are snow emergency routes. The routes can also be identified by the red, white, and blue emergency signs posted every few blocks on these streets. This route can be found on the city of Hastings website:
