

WHAT IS MOBILITY PLANNING?



- An integrated strategy to enhance personal mobility and support the goals of other plans
 - Imagine Hastings Comprehensive Development Plan
 - Universal Mobility, Walkability and Connectivity Studies
 - Parks, trails, Neighborhood and Corridor Plans, etc.
- Identification, selection, and prioritization of Actions that best support the goals of these plans
 - Projects
 - Tools e.g. Policy/Code changes, Street design guides, etc.
 - Funding Strategies
- Actions developed through a highly transparent and public process


