PROPERLY TARP YOUR VEHICLE

Litter and debris are serious **HAZARDS** when not properly secured and covered on vehicles traveling to the landfill. On a short drive in Hastings or Adams County one will observe litter along the streets and highways. Not only is illegal dumping on the rise, increased use of plastic packaging by today's consumer, in addition to reckless litterbugs contribute to the debris/litter which regularly accumulates in the ditches and along the roadsides of Hastings and throughout Adams County.

When traveling to the local sanitary landfill, pickups, trucks, open top trailers and containers **must have the tarps tied down securely** along the front, rear and sides of the load. Even vehicles with hydraulic tarps need to be secured along the sides of the container to provide a tight fit to prevent blowing and/or falling debris and litter.

Hastings Solid Waste department funds are budgeted for regular litter collection along West Highway 6, West 2nd Street and South Southern Hills Drive. The Hastings Solid Waste Facility also spends numerous dollars on public education with regard for "the need to properly secure and tarp loads." Landfill customers must remember in addition to fines, there is significant liability involved when waste materials fall from a vehicle. The waste can cause property damage and personal injury to other motorists.
