## **Know What's Below**

If you're already making plans for your next outdoor project, the Hastings Utilities Department can help you with the first step to ensure a safe and lasting outcome. Important utility services are buried just underneath the ground's surface. We can help prevent damage to those utility lines, saving you from repair costs, loss of use and injury.

## **Nebraska811 – Call Before You Dig**

Nebraska811 is a free service for anyone who is planning a digging project, including homeowners and professional excavators. Nebraska State law requires anyone who digs to place a locate request at least two full business days before digging by calling 811 or visiting [www.ne1call.com](http://www.ne1call.com). Once your request is submitted, our Utilities Department will locate and mark the lines. Once a site has been accurately marked or we've communicated to the excavator that they are clear, it is safe to begin digging.

## **Electronic Waste Collection Event**

The Hastings Solid Waste Landfill is holding an electronic waste collection event in March for residential households.

Who: Residents in Adams County (Households only; no businesses/schools/government entities)

What: Bring unwanted electronic items to be recycled

Where: Solid Waste Landfill at 725 S. Southern Hills Drive

When: March 25 from 8 a.m. to 4:45 p.m., and March 26 from 8 a.m. to noon

Additional Details: Waste materials accepted include laptop computers, hard drives, computer monitors, TVs, and fluorescent lamps that are 8 feet or less. Limited quantities will apply. For more information, contact the Landfill at 402-463-0705. The event is funded by a Nebraska Department of Environment and Energy Waste Reduction and Recycling Incentive grant.
