

# *Water Improvements for a Better Community*

## **Committed to Quality**

The City of Hastings is taking charge of the community's aging water main system with a comprehensive replacement plan. Experts looked at miles and miles of aging pipes and created a plan that focuses on the most immediate needs first. It's a huge undertaking, but the next 10 years of projects are already being planned.

## **2022 and Beyond**

Three water main replacement projects are planned for 2022, which include the following areas:

- 5<sup>th</sup> Street from Minnesota Avenue to California Avenue
- 7<sup>th</sup> Street from Minnesota Avenue to Cedar Avenue
- 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Streets from East Side Boulevard to California Avenue

Replacement projects will continue each year until all outdated pipes are replaced.

## **Knowledge is Power for Fair Housing**
