

Final Fall Project? Call Before You Dig

Call 811 for the Diggers Hotline

Nebraska811 is a free service for anyone who is planning a digging project, including homeowners and professional excavators. Nebraska State law requires anyone who digs to place a locate request at least two full business days before digging. Once your request is submitted, the Hastings Utilities Department will locate and mark your lines. By placing a call or an online request at ne1call.com with Nebraska811, damage to underground utility lines can be prevented as well as costs for repairs, loss of use and injury.

What You'll Need to File a Request

- Your name, phone and email
- The address of your dig site
- The side of the street your dig site is on
- The nearest intersecting road
- Start date
- Work type
- Explosives, equipment and premarking
- Marking instructions and remarks

Renting in Hastings? Your Rights with the Fair Housing Administration

Housing providers are required to make a reasonable accommodation in their rules, policies, practices and procedures, and to allow reasonable modifications (changes to the physical structure) for individuals with disabilities. A request need not be in writing, but it is recommended that a request be made in writing so that there is a record of both the request and the date it was sent.
