

# *Water Improvements for a Better Community*

## **Committed to Quality**

The City of Hastings is taking charge of the community's aging water main system with a comprehensive replacement plan. Experts looked at miles and miles of aging pipes and created a plan that focuses on the most immediate needs first. It's a huge undertaking, but the next 10 years of projects are already being planned.

## **2023 and Beyond**

Three water main replacement projects are planned for 2023, which include the following areas:

- 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> California to 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave.
- Finishing 7<sup>th</sup> Street from Minnesota Avenue to Cedar Avenue
- 5<sup>th</sup> St. Minnesota to 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave.

Replacement projects will continue each year until all outdated pipes are replaced.

Customers on Seventh Street who have non-lead services have been or will be tied over to the new main by contractor Van Kirk Brothers Contracting. Customers who have lead services will receive full replacements and tie over to the new main by the HU water service installation crew.

## **Knowledge is Power for Fair Housing**
