

ORDINANCE NO. 4842

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HASTINGS, NEBRASKA, INCREASING THE ADAMS COUNTY ENHANCED 911 SURCHARGE FOR THE HASTINGS 911 CENTER; REPEALING INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HASTINGS, NEBRASKA:

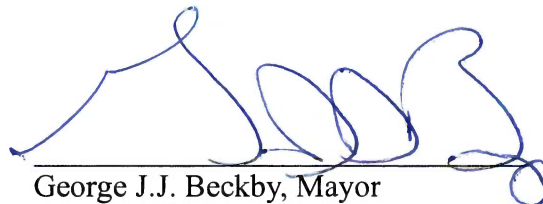
Section 1. That, pursuant to Neb. Rev. St. 86-1078, the Enhanced 911 service surcharge for exchange access lines within Adams County, Nebraska is increased from seventy-five cents (\$0.75) per month per line to one dollar (\$1.00) per month per line in order to offset rising operational, maintenance, and technology costs associated with providing Enhanced 911 emergency communications services throughout Adams County.

Section 2. Any ordinance passed and approved prior to the passage, approval, and publication or posting of this ordinance and in conflict with its provisions is repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be published in the manner and form provided by law and shall take effect and be in full force from and after its due passage, approval, and publication in the electronic form.

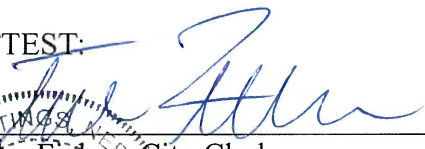

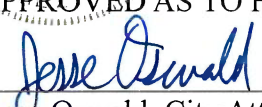
